



Brother Design Stars 2017 Terms & Conditions

1. Registration for the 2017 Brother Design Stars promotion constitutes acceptance of these Terms & Conditions.
2. The Registration Form must be completed online at www.brotherdesignstars.co.nz before 5pm Friday 7 July 2016.
3. A completed Entry Form and finished entries must be received no later than 5pm, Friday 14 July 2017. No entries will be accepted after 5pm Friday 14 July 2017.
4. You will receive a courier ticket to cover postage to get your entry to Auckland for judging if a completed Registration Form is received by Friday 30 June 2017.
5. Teachers who have registered a class and completed Entry Forms (School Entry) by Friday 30 June 2017 will receive a courier ticket to cover postage to get of all students' entries to Auckland for judging.
6. All finished entries must be couriered or hand delivered to The Organiser, Brother Design Stars Awards Office c/o Goode PR, Samsung Building, 24 Warehouse Way, Northcote, Auckland 0627. No entries will be accepted by standard post.
7. At least one photo or sketch which showcases how your entry is to be worn or displayed must be included with all entries (as outlined in the Entry Form). It is your responsibility to obtain appropriate written permission from any model who appears in the photo as this image may be used for publicity purposes. You must be able to provide written evidence of this consent, if required.
8. Entrants must be New Zealand residents, in school years 7 to 13. Entrants do not need to be enrolled at school however must not be currently enrolled in tertiary study, i.e. polytech or university at the close of entry on Friday 14 July 2017.
9. A teacher or guardian must acknowledge permission on the Entry Form if the entrant is aged 16 years or younger at the close of entry date.
10. Entrants can submit **one** entry into the fashion or craft award, or enter both award categories with separate entries. A separate Entry Form must be completed for each entry.
11. Garments/designs must fit the categories as outlined below:
 - **BROTHER DESIGN STARS CRAFT AWARD**
A unique and eye-catching hat or piece of head wear that represents the theme, 'Steal the Show'.
 - **BROTHER DESIGN STARS FASHION AWARD**
A runway-ready fashion item, or outfit, that represents the theme, 'Steal the Show'.

12. Garments/designs must be the entrant's own work. Construction of the Craft Award and Fashion Award entries can be with assistance but this must be formally acknowledged on the Entry Form.
13. Once garments are in the hands of the organisers, they cannot be uplifted until released by the organisers.
14. The organisers take no responsibility for garments lost or damaged in transit. Please ensure the courier address is correct and the entry is well packaged to avoid damage in transit.
15. Organisers may keep prize-winning garments for up to **three months** after the awards for promotion and display purposes. All care will be taken with the entrant's work however the organisers will not be responsible for any loss or damage.
16. If your entry is chosen to be featured as part of the *New Zealand Fashion Week Graduate Show supported by Brother*, organisers may make minor adjustments to your entry/entries to fit the model/s.
17. If you include bought (not made by you) accessories to be worn with your entry (i.e. hat, shoes, belt), these will not be judged as standalone pieces and may be excluded from the *New Zealand Fashion Week Graduate Show, supported by Brother*.
18. Entrants entering the Fashion Award are asked to follow the assigned Garment Sizing Guidelines (as outlined on www.brotherdesignstars.co.nz, under the Categories tab). This will also be supplied on the Entry Form.
19. If chosen as a category winner, you agree to be available to travel to Auckland with a parent/guardian during the week of August 28 to 1 September, 2017.
20. If you are a finalist you agree to be photographed and available for publicity purposes, including media interviews from July 31, 2017.
21. If you are a finalist you agree to have your entry/entries showcased on the runway as part of the *New Zealand Fashion Week Graduate Show supported by Brother*.
22. All entrants agree to make their garments/design available to be showcased in other promotional activity organised by Brother NZ. Entrants agree to allow photographs of their entries to be reproduced in newspapers, magazines, catalogues and electronic and social media in order to advertise and promote this competition and future promotions.
23. Prizes are not transferable, re-saleable or exchangeable (for cash or alternative goods), in whole or in part. In the event that a specified prize or prizes become unavailable for any reason, the Organiser may substitute that prize or prizes for another prize or prizes of like value. The Organiser will not be responsible for the cancellation or postponement of any prize or the event.
24. All fashion entries where the entrant is from Auckland can be submitted into Raise Up's *Walk the Line* competition. The organisers will be responsible for getting all entries from the Brother Design Stars awards office to the organisers of Walk the Line for the dress rehearsal on Saturday 12 August 2017.

25. Garments will only be available for pickup from The Brother Design Stars Awards Office, Goode PR, Samsung Building, 24 Warehouse Way, Northcote, Auckland 0627 on the allocated 'pick up' day. Those not being picked up at this time must include a return courier ticket included along with a correct return address. Clear directions for the return of entries must be included.
26. Any entries that have not included a return courier ticket, or are not picked up on the allocated 'pick up' day, will remain property of Brother NZ and may be recycled or otherwise disposed of.
27. The judging panel's decision is final and no further correspondence will be entered into.

PRIVACY STATEMENT

The Organiser will hold any and all personal information in accordance with the provisions of the Privacy Act 1993. Entrants have the right to access and request correction of their own personal information. Any personal information held by the Organiser will be used only for the purpose for which it was provided and will not be retained for any longer than necessary. It will not be disclosed to any other person or agency without the individual's express consent, unless required by law, or if disclosure is necessary in connection with any breach of these Terms and Conditions.
