

STAMP YOUR STYLE

Update a white linen throw with a shock of neon-coloured stamps

YOU WILL NEED

- Linen fabric
- Iron
- Large potato
- Sharp knife
- Thin paint brush
- Fabric paint

1 Wash, dry and iron a large square of linen fabric. Lay the linen down on a flat surface. Either keep the edges frayed for a deconstructed look or sew edges for a clean finish.

2 Cut potato in half and carefully carve out a raised rectangular shape using a sharp knife. Either make one stamp and re-use it, or make multiples for different colours.

3 Paint a thin layer of fabric paint onto your potato stamp. Practise stamping onto a paper towel to figure out how much paint to use.

4 Stamp onto the linen. Reapply paint after every stamp for consistency.

5 Leave the fabric to dry (roughly four hours). Iron linen to set the fabric paint.
