

## Projects > Potholder

This trendy little potholder is great in your kitchen and makes a perfect gift!

### Materials and Supplies

- [Brother Sewing/Embroidery Machine](#)
- [Blind Stitch Foot](#)
- Two 8" squares of cotton fabric
- One 8" square of cotton batting (cotton batting tends to be more heat resistant)
- 1½ yards of ¾" wide bias strip
- Thread to match binding

### Instructions

1. Sandwich batting and fabrics together with the batting in the middle. Place fabric squares on top and bottom of batting right sides facing out.
2. Baste around all four sides.
3. Insert binding into binder giving a one-inch lead through the foot and attach to machine.
4. Starting at one corner, place one side of the potholder into the center of the binder.
5. Using a straight stitch, stitch around all four sides taking care around corners.
6. Make a loop with the excess binding at the last corner to form a hanger for potholder.



**Note:** Readymade binding was used for this project.
