

Note Book Pouch

Two cute and funky projects to carry your Note Book or Tablet



Designed by Christine Mitchell.

Read instructions carefully before starting project.

- A. Finished size 9½"(24cm) high x 8¼"(21cm) wide. To fit Note Book 8 ½" x 7 ¼"
B. Finished size 9¼" (23.5cm) high x 6¼" (16.5cm) wide. To fit Note Book 8"x 5 ¼"

Materials:

- 25cm zip
- Thread to complement fabric
- .3mt Medium weight Pellon
- Remnants of fabric for applique, charm squares are perfect
- .3mt Patterned fabric for back and lining, avoid one way prints
- 30cm x 30cm Plain fabric for front
- .30cm x 30cm Fusible web

Tools required:

- Brother Sewing machine, instruction book and accessories, scissors, pins, iron, and ruler or measuring tape.

Optional:

- Brother ScanNCut
- Cutting mat, ruler and cutter

Check the size of your Note Book/ Tablet to compare;

- If the difference is the height, add or minus to the pattern bottom.
- If the difference is the width, add or minus to the pattern side.

Preparation for and Applique:

1. If appliqueing or machine embroidering the bag front, cut a little larger and trim to size after decorating

2. Cut the remaining pattern pieces to the measurements given on the above pattern. Cut either with length wise or cross wise grainline.

3. Iron pellon pieces to the front and to the back bag panels as per manufacturer's instructions.

4. Applique through fabric and pellon for the bag front.

5. Or machine embroider design with a tear a way backing, iron on pellon after removing the tear a way. **Miss next steps until 16**

6. If using the Brother ScanNCut use manufacturer's instructions to cut your applique.

Download design with this pattern. **Miss next steps and go to step 9**

7. If you don't have a ScanNCut trace applique templates onto the paper side of fusible web.

8. Roughly cut out leaving a small margin around each shape.

9. Iron shapes to the back of your charm squares or fabric scraps using manufacturer's instructions.

10. Carefully cut out along lines (mini irons are perfect for this).

11. Finger crease centre of front, lay out applique, until happy with placement.

12.



Peel backing from branch, lower body, feathers and feet.

13.



Using your favourite darning foot, needle position centre and feed dog's lowered free motion around branch, feet and feathers.

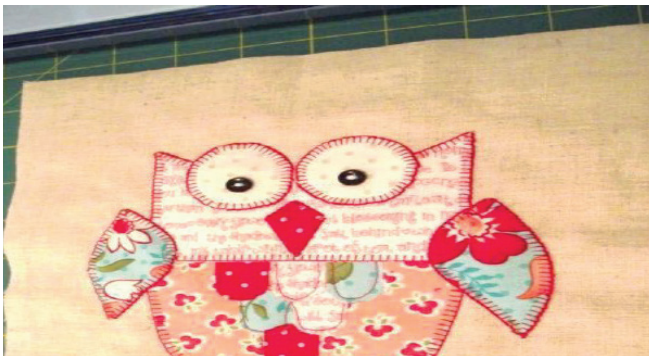
Position head just over the top of lower body and feathers. Arrange other pieces and fuse to bag front.

15.



Using blanket stitch, stitch around remaining shapes.

16.



Find centre of design and cut to front bag size.

Construction:

1.



Place zip face down on bag front and pin to the top edge (zip is longer).

2.



Cover zip with front lining and re-pin. Zip will extend past right hand side.

3.



Using straight stitch, centre needle position and your zipper foot. I stitch seam using edge of foot on the edge of the fabric as guide.

4. Trim pella from seams as you go.

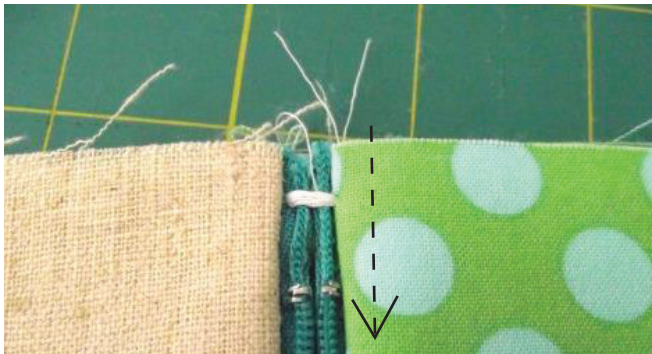
5.



With the other side of the zip face down on the top edge of the bag back. Pin. Cover with the zip guard and then the back lining fabric right sides together continue as the front.

6. Close zip.

7.



Open bag out, bag back, Pellon and lining on one side of the zip and bag front, Pellon and lining on the other

Replace zipper foot with multipurpose foot J. Zig zag stitch width 7, stitch length 0. Stitch on the spot over the two sides of the zip to hold zip together. (also through zip guard)

8. Set for straight stitch and needle position centre, topstitch bag back through all back layers 1cm from zip.

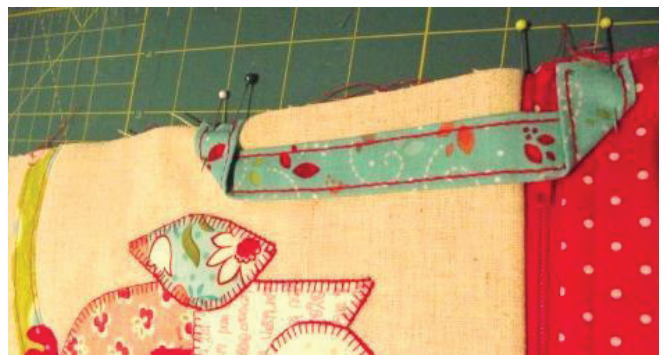
Crease bag handle down the centre and then fold raw edges to the centre crease line. Press and fold again to inclose raw edges. Now four layers.

10.



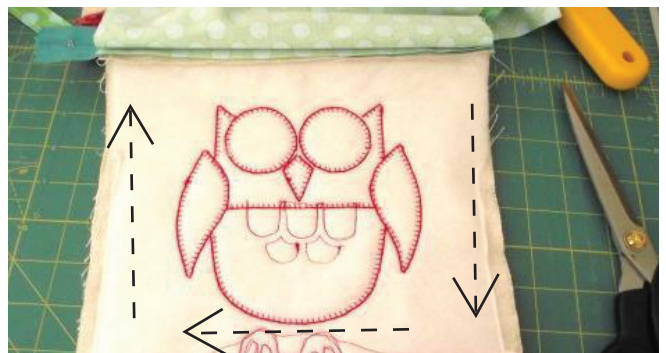
Triple topstitch along both edges. Use the stitch width function to move the needle position to suit.

11.



Fold bag to find bag top, pin to mark position. Open bag out again, fold and pin handle starting at pin mark, see above picture. Be careful not to catch front lining. Make sure only the ends will be attached in the seam. Tack handle to bag.

12.



Place right side of bag front to right side of bag back together, aligning bottom edges. Using

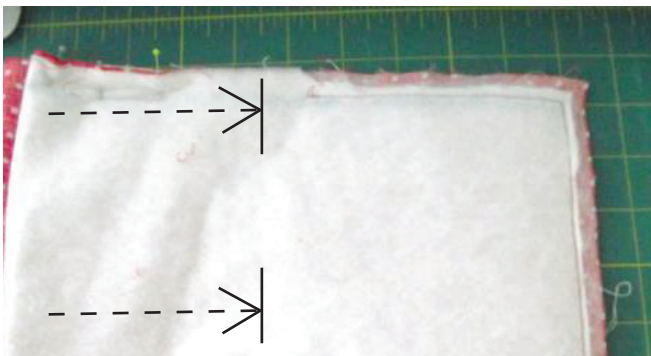
a straight stitch sew, 1cm seam from half way down one side, across the bottom and up the other side half way. Trim pellaon as you go.

13.



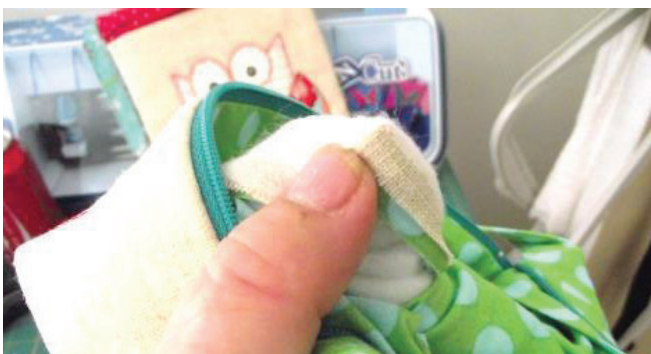
Right sides of front and back lining together sew as outer bag, however leave 3" opening in base of lining to turn bag through.

14.



Bag still inside out, zip half open, lining base and bag base together, stitch each side from top to just past half way.

15.



Turn right side out through hole in lining. Fold seams into corners and hold as you turn through.

16. Slip stitch lining closed or fold raw edges in and edge stitch along opening.

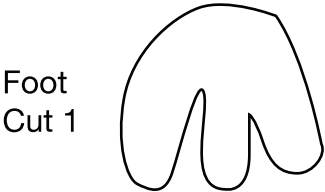
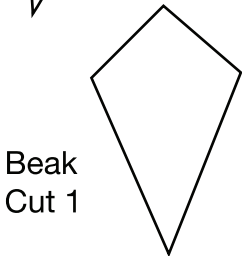
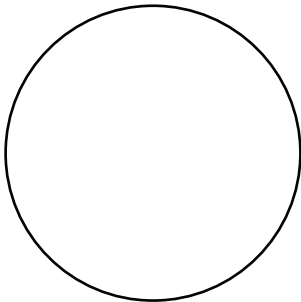
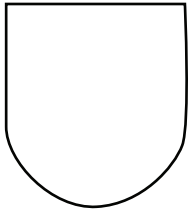
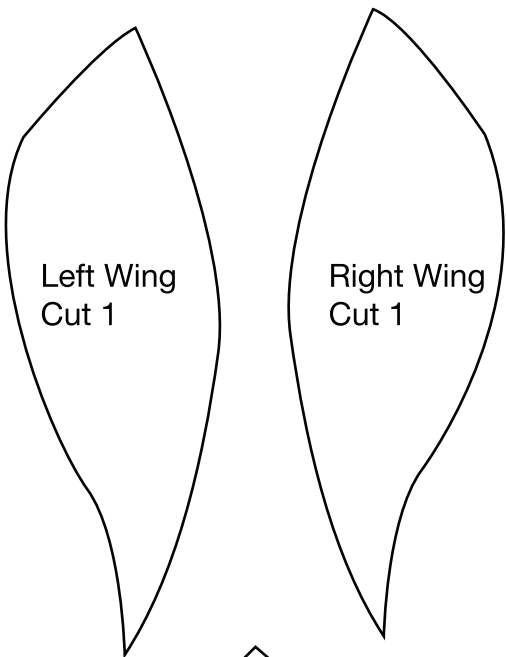
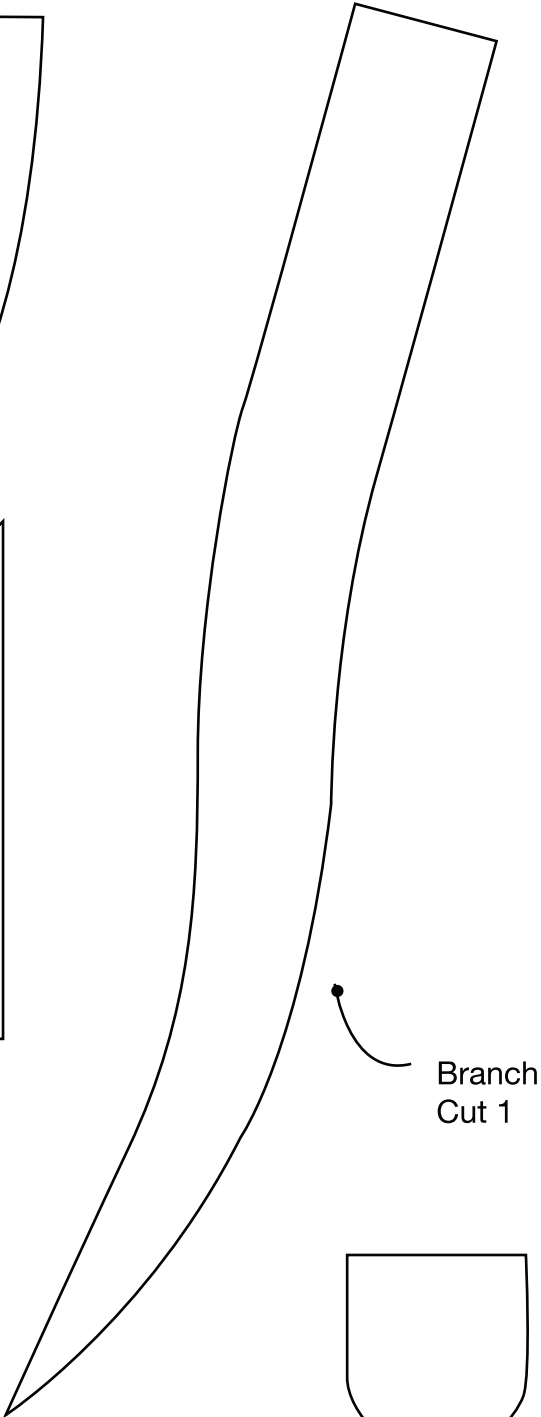
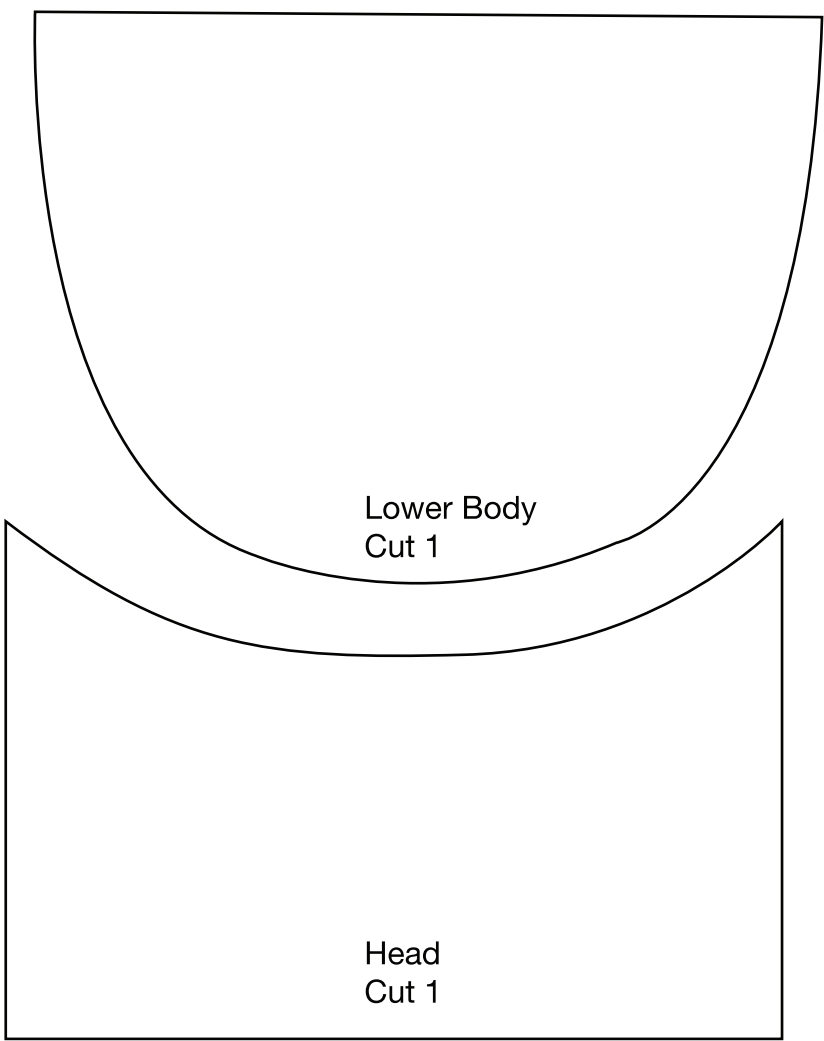
This handy little bag can be made any size. Decide on the size of the bag front, and then add 2" (5cm) in height to this measurement for the back.

Congratulations your Note Book Pouch is now finished.

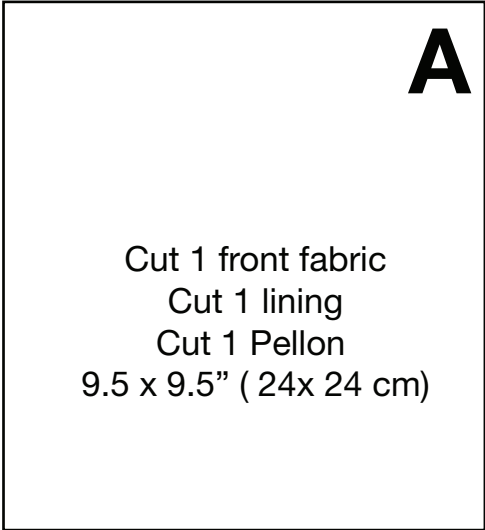
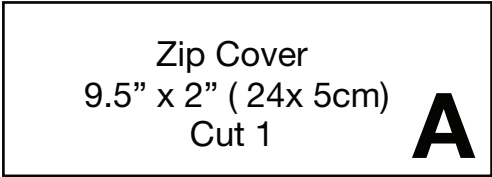
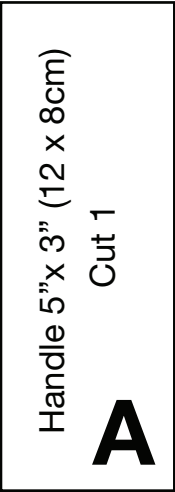
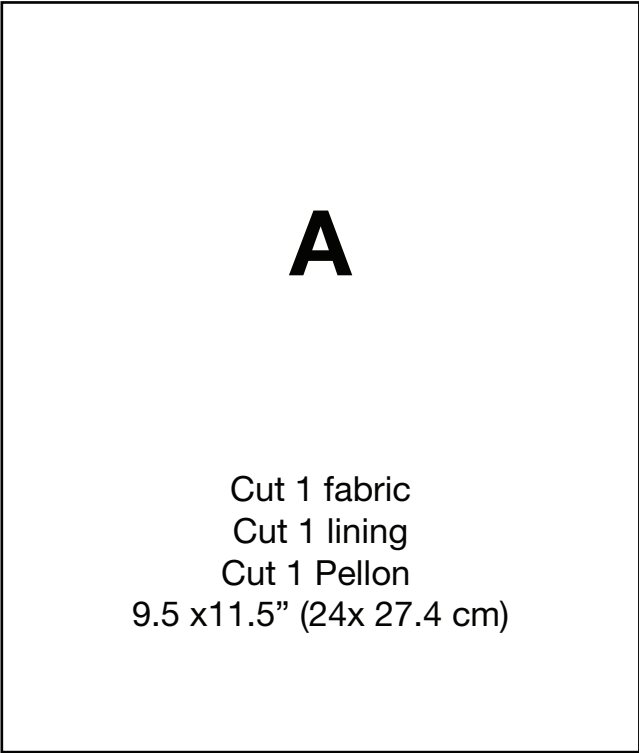


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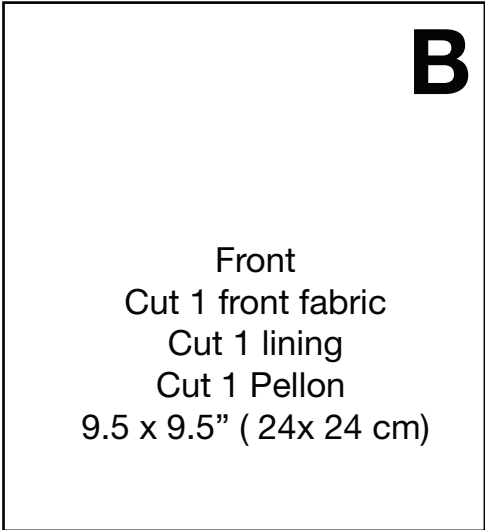
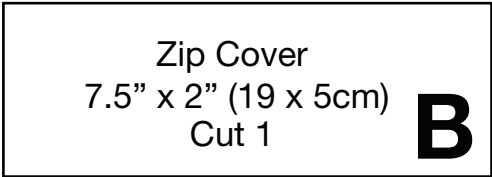
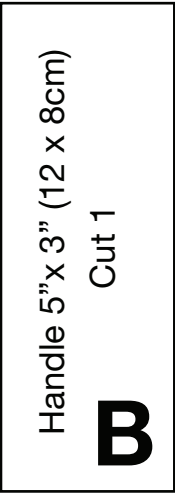
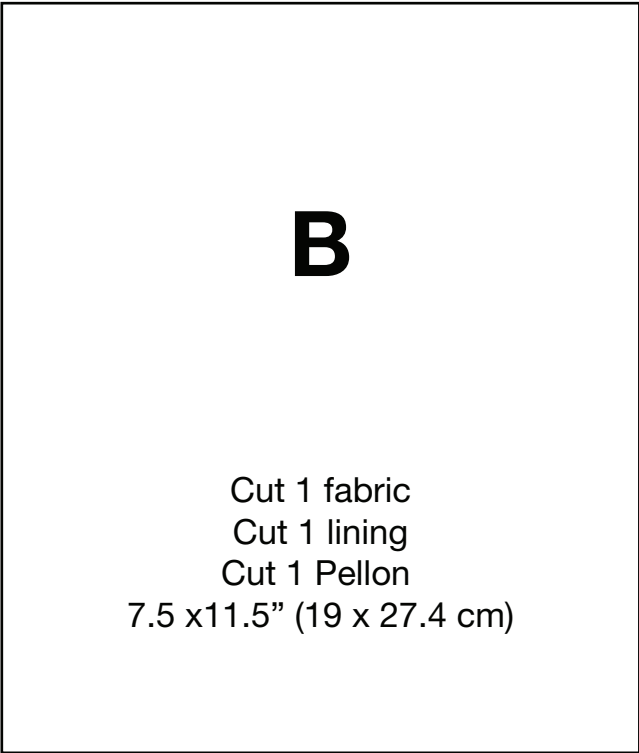
