

Reversible Pillow Case

The perfect teen project. Finished size 72x 48cm

Read instructions carefully before starting project.

Materials:

- 19" (50cm) Main fabric
- 19" (50cm) Contrast fabric
- Matching threads

Tools required:

- Brother Sewing Machine
- Pins
- Scissors
- Measuring tape

Cutting Instructions:

1. Cut side one of pillow case 19" x 33" (50 x 85cm)
2. Cut side two of pillow case 19" x 43" (50 x 110cm)

Construction:

1.



Take the pillow case side one and iron a 2" (5cm) fold on one of the 19" (50cm) edges, fold again to form a hem.

2.

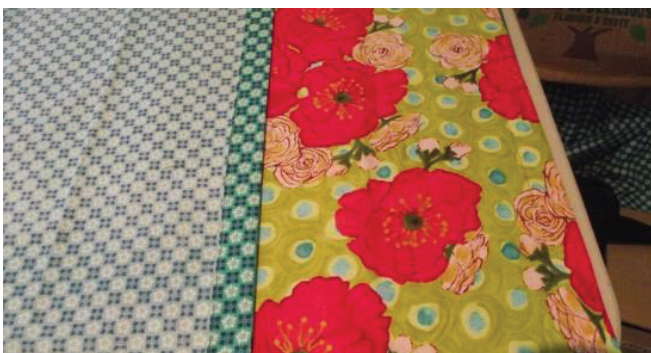


Straight stitch hem down

3. Repeat for pillowcase side two.

4. Lay side two right side up.

5.



Place side one face down on side two right side up and matching raw edges together.

Side two extends past the front.

6.



Fold flap back over side one.

7.



Pin the raw edges together and sew 0.3" (1cm) seam, neaten with over lock stitch.

8. Fold right side out and give a good press with your iron.

Congratulations your reversible pillowcase is now finished.



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
